

What is Praise (Hallu/Halal)?

Scripture Commands all living creatures to Hallu/Halal (Praise) יהוה (Yahuah) (**Psalm 150:6**).

Enter his gates with thanksgiving (Todah), and his courts with Praise (Tehillah/Singing)! Give thanks (Todah) to him; Barak (Bless) his Name! **Psalm 100:4**

יהוה, HALLU (HALAL) "PRAISE"

ה = Hey (H) Look Reveal, Breath

ל = Lamed (L) Yoke, To Bind

ו = Uau (U) Add, Secure

Look, Reveal, through your Breath. To Yoke, and to Bind ourselves to Aluhym. Add, and be Secure.

Look, Reveal, through your Breath. To Yoke, and to Bind ourselves to Aluhym. Add, and be Secure. Throw up your hands along with your voice, and Work, at giving יהוה (Yahuah) all your Worship. Look, Reveal, through your Breath.

HLLU (Halal) 1984 is a primary Hebrew root word used in Hebrew for Praise. The word "HalluYAH (**Psalm 106:1**) was only written one (1) time, Hallu is written 33 times in the Tanakh (OT) for Praise in Hebrew. This Hebrew word was also written in Greek as HalleluYah" which comes from this base word. It means "to be clear, to shine, to boast, show, to rave, celebrate, to be clamorously foolish. In Greek"

Tehillah 8416 is derived from the word halal and means "the singing of Hallu/Halal (Praise)'s, to sing or to laud; perceived to involve music, especially singing; hymns of the Ruch (Spirit).

Yadah 3034 is a verb with a root meaning, "the extended hand, to throw out the hand, therefore to praise with extended hand."

Todah comes from the same principle root word as yadah, but is used more specifically. Todah literally means, "thank you, an extension of the hand in adoration, avowal, or acceptance." By

way of application, it is apparent in the Psalms and elsewhere that it is used for thanking **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) for "things not yet received" as well as things already at hand.

Zamar means "to pluck the strings of an instrument, to sing, to Hallu/Halal (Praise); a musical word which is largely involved with joyful expressions of music with musical instruments.

MEANING OF PRAISE:

The word Praise comes from the Latin pretium, "price," or "value," and may be defined generally as an ascription of value or worth. Praise may be bestowed upon unworthy objects or from improper motives, but true praise consists in a sincere acknowledgment of a real conviction of worth. Its type may be seen in the representation given in adoration of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) and of his son **וְיֵשׁוּעָא** (Yahusha), which is inspired by a sense of their worthiness to be adored (**Revelation 4:11; Revelation 5:12**).

1. (v.) Especially, the joyful tribute of gratitude or homage rendered to the Divine Being; the act of glorifying or extolling the Creator; worship, particularly worship by song, distinction from prayer and other acts of worship; as, a service of Hallu/Halal (Praise).
2. (v.) To extol in words or song; to magnify; to glorify on account of perfections or excellent works; to do honor to; to display the excellence of; -- applied especially to the Divine Being.
3. (v.) Commendation for worth; approval expressed; honor rendered because of excellence or worth; laudation; approbation.
4. (v.) To value; to appraise.
- 5.(v.) To commend; to applaud; to express approbation of; to laud; -- applied to a person or his acts.
6. (n.) The object, ground, or reason of Hallu/Halal (Praise).

אֱלֹהִים (YAHUAH) IS THE OBJECT OF HALLU (PRAISE)

In scripture it is **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) who is especially brought before us as the object of Hallu/ Halal (Praise). His whole creation Hallu/ Halal (Praise) Him, from the Malakym (Angels) of Shamym (Heavens) (**Psalms 103:20, Revelation 5:11**). But it is with the Hallu/ Halal (Praises) offered to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) by man, and with the human duty of Praising **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), that the Scriptures are principally concerned.

Psalms uses the term Hallu/Halal (Praise) 50 times. (13) thirteen times in six (6) verses. The first (1st) verse provides the "where" of Hallu/Halal (Praise)—everywhere! "Hallu/Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) in his sanctuary; Hallu/Halal (Praise) him in his mighty Shamym (Heavens).

- The next verse teaches "why" to Hallu/Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah): "Hallu/Halal (Praise) him for his acts of power; Hallu/Halal (Praise) him for his surpassing greatness."

- Verses 3–6 note "how" to Hallu/Halal (Praise) **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah)—with a variety of instruments, dance, and everything that has breath.

The Hebrew words translated as "Praise" have a deeper meaning than is conveyed in English. They instruct the worshiper to take specific physical action.

THE GROUNDS OF HALLU/HALAL (PRAISE)

Sometimes **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is praised for His inherent qualities. His majesty (**Psalm 104:1**) or Qadoshness (Holiness) (**Isaiah 6:3**) fills the mind, and He is "glorified as Aluhym (God)" (**Romans 1:21**) More frequently He is praised for His works in creation, providence, and redemption.

THE MODES OF PRAISE

True Hallu/Halal (Praise) of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), as distinguished from false Hallu/Halal (Praise) (**Isaiah 29:13, Matthew 15:8**), is first (1st) of all an inward emotion—a gladness and rejoicing of the heart (**Psalm 4:7; Psalm 33:21**), a music of the Soul and Ruch (Spirit) (**Psalm 103:1, Luke 1:46**), which no language can adequately express (**Psalm 106:2, 2 Corinthians 9:15**). But utterance is natural to strong emotion, and the mouth instinctively strives to express the Hallu/Halal (Praise) of the heart (**Psalm 51:15**).

Many of the most moving passages in Scripture come from the inspiration of the Ruch (Spirit) of Hallu/Halal (Praise) awakened by the power, the wisdom, the kindness and but above all by the revelation of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah)'s redeeming Aahbah (love).

The one who Zamar (Praises) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) desires to Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him in the hearing of other men (**Psalm 40:10**), and desires also that their Hallu/Halal (Praise) should be joined with his own (**Psalm 34:3**). Further, the Ruch (Spirit) of Hallu/Halal (Praise) is a Ruch (Spirit) of song. It may find expression in other ways—in sacrifice (**Leviticus 7:13**), or testimony (**Psalm 66:16**), or prayer (**Colossians 1:3**); but it finds its most natural and its fullest utterance in lyrical and musical forms.

When **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) fills the heart with Hallu/Halal (Praise), He puts a new song into the mouth (**Psalm 40:3**). The Book of Psalms is the proof of this from the Tanakh (Old Testament). And when we enter into the New Covenant we find that it is alike for Malakym (Angels) and for Mankind, for the higher moods of Hallu/Halal (Praise) express themselves in bursts of song (**Luke 2:14 Ephesians 5:19, Colossians 3:16, Revelation 5:9, Revelation 14:3, Revelation 15:3**).

Both in the Tanakh (Old Testament) and Brit Hadashah (New Testament), the Ruch (spirit) of song gives birth to public Hallu/Halal (Praise). In their earlier expressions the Zamar (Praises) of Yasharal were joyful outbursts in which song was mingled with shouting and dancing to an accompaniment of timbrels and shofar's (**Exodus 15:20 2 Samuel 6:5, 14**).

THE DUTY OF HALLU/HALAL (PRAISE)

Hallu/Halal (Praise) is represented in scripture as a duty no less than a natural impulse and a delight. To fail in this duty is to withhold from **יְהוָה** (Yahuah)'s esteem that belongs to Him (**Psalm 50:23 Romans 1:20**); it is to shut one's eyes to the signs of His presence (**Isaiah 40:26**), to be forgetful of His mercies (**Deuteronomy 6:12**), and be unthankful for His kindness (**Luke 6:35**).

The book of Psalm is a collection of songs filled with Hallu/ Halal (Praises) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah). Among them is **Psalm 9**, which says, "I will be glad and rejoice in you; I will sing the Zamar (Praises) of your Name, O Most High" (verse 2). **Psalm 18:3** says **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is "worthy of Hallu/Halal (Praise)." **Psalm 21:13** Zamar (Praises) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) both for

who He is and for His great power: “Be exalted in your strength, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah); we will sing and Hallu/Halal (Praise) your might.”

Scriptural worship is expressed not only with our whole life (**Romans 12:1**), but with our whole body. Scripture models corporate praise as a whole group activity. It has nothing to do with entertainment or putting on a show to attract seekers. It is intended for everyone to participate in honoring **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) together, corporately as one (1) (Ecad).

Actions speak louder than words. Your outward expression reveals your heart attitude. Sometimes we don't feel like worshiping and praising, we have to choose to Hallu/Halal (Praise) even when we don't feel like it.

Choosing to engage with **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) will change your attitude. **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) promises to reward those who choose to draw near to him (**James 4:8**) Literally, choosing to Hallu/Halal (Praise) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is a transformative experienced.

ATTITUDE OF PRAISE

Hebrews 13:15 Through Him then, let us continually offer up a sacrifice of Hallu/Halal (Praise) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), that is, the fruit of lips that give thanks to His Name.

Eternal Hallu/Halal (Praise) For they exchanged the truth of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) for a lie, and worshiped and served the creature rather than the Creator, who is Baruk (Blessed) forever. Aman.

Psalms 104:33 I will sing to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) as long as I live; I will sing Zamar (Praises) to my Aluhym (God) while I have my being. I Will Sing Zamar (Praise).

Jeremiah 20:13 Sing to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), Hallu/Halal (Praise) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah)! For He has delivered the soul of the needy one From the hand of evildoers. Hallu/Halal (Praise) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah)!

Psalms 105:45 So that they might keep His statutes And observe His Turah, Hallu/Halal (Praise) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah)!

Psalms 145:3 Great is **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), and highly to be Hallu/Halal (Praised), And His greatness is unsearchable.

2 Samuel 22:4 "I call upon **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), who is worthy to be Hallu/Halal (Praised), And I am saved from my enemies.

Psalms 68:32 Sing to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), O kingdoms of the earth, Sing Zamar (praises) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), Selah.

Psalms 47:7 For **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is the King of all the earth; Sing Zamar (praises) with a skillful psalm.

Isaiah 43:21 "The people whom I formed for Myself Will declare My Hallu/Halal (Praise).

Ezra 3:11 They sang, Hallu/Halal (Praising) and Yadah (giving thanks) to **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), saying, "For He is good, for His loving kindness is upon Yasharal (Israel) forever." And all the people shouted with a great shout when they Hallu/Halal (Praised) **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) because the foundation of the house of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) was laid.

Psalms 35:28 And my tongue shall declare Your righteousness And Your Hallu/Halal (Praise) all day long.

James 5:13 Is anyone among you suffering? Then he must pray Is anyone cheerful? He is to sing Hallu/Halal (Praises).

Exodus 15:2 "אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah) is my strength and song, And He has become my salvation; This is my Aluhym (God), and I will Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him; My father's Aluhym (God), and I will extol Him.

Deuteronomy 10:21 "He is your Hallu/Halal (Praises) and He is your Aluhym (God), who has done these great and awesome things for you which your eyes have seen.

Judges 5:3 "Hear, O kings; give ear, O rulers! To אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), I will sing, I will sing Hallu/Halal (Praises) to אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), the Aluhym (God) of Yasharal.

2 Samuel 22:50 "Therefore I will Yadah (give thanks) to You, O אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), among the nations, And I will sing Zamar (Praise) to Your Name.

1 Chronicles 29:13 "Now therefore, our Aluhym (God), we thank You (Todah), and Hallu/Halal (Praise) Your glorious name.

Psalms 35:18 I will give You thanks in the great congregation; I will Hallu/Halal (Praise) You among a mighty throng.

Psalms 35:28 And my tongue shall declare Your righteousness And Your Hallu/Halal (Praise) all day long.

Psalms 43:4 Then I will go to the altar of אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), To אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah) my exceeding joy; And upon the lyre I shall Hallu/Halal (Praise) You, O אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), my Aluhym (God).

Psalms 100:4 Enter His gates with thanksgiving And His courts with Hallu/Halal (Praise), Todah (Give thanks) to Him, Barak (Bless) His name.

Psalms 101:1 I will sing of loving kindness and justice, To You, O אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), I will sing Zamar (Praises).

Psalms 138:1 I will give You thanks with all my heart; I will sing Zamar (Praises) to You before the Aluhym (gods).

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), and I will be healed; Save me and I will be saved, For You are my Hallu/Halal (Praise).

Daniel 2:23 "To You, O Aluhym (God) of my fathers, I Todah (give thanks) and Hallu/Halal (Praise), For You have given me wisdom and power; Even now You have made known to me what we requested of You, For You have made known to us the king's matter."

Exodus 15:11 "Who is like You among the Aluhym (gods), O אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah)? Who is like You, majestic in Qadoshnes (holiness), Awesome in Zamar (Praises), working wonders?"

2 Samuel 22:4 "I call upon אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), who is worthy to be Hallu/Halal (Praised), And I am saved from my enemies.

1 Chronicles 16:9 Sing to Him, sing Zamar (Praises) to Him; Speak of all His wonders.

1 Chronicles 16:25 For great is אֲיָהוָה (Yahuah), and greatly to be Hallu/Halal (Praised); He

also is to be feared above all Aluhym (gods).

1 Chronicles 16:34-36 O Todah (give thanks) to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), for He is good; For His loving kindness is everlasting. Then say, "Save us, O אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) of our salvation, And gather us and deliver us from the nations, To give thanks to Your Qadosh (holy) name, And glory in Your Hallu/Halal (Praise)." Barak (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), the Aluhym (God) of Yasharal (Israel), From everlasting even to everlasting Then all the people said, "Aman," and Hallu/Halal (Praise) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah).

2 Chronicles 5:13-14 in unison when the trumpeters and the singers were to make themselves heard with one (1) voice to Hallu/Halal (Praise) and to esteem (glorify) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), and when they lifted up their voice accompanied by trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and when they Hallu/Halal (Praised) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) saying, "He indeed is good for His loving kindness is everlasting," then the house, the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud, for the esteem of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) filled the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah).

2 Chronicles 7:3 All the sons of Yasharal (Israel), seeing the fire come down and the esteem (glory) of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) upon the house, bowed down on the pavement with their faces to the ground, and they worshiped and gave Hallu/Halal (Praise) to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), saying, "Truly He is good, truly His loving kindness is everlasting."

Ezra 3:11 They sang, Hallu/Halal (Praising) and giving thanks to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), saying, "For He is good, for His loving kindness is upon Yasharal forever." And all the people shouted with a great shout when they Hallu/Halal (Praised) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) because the foundation of the house of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) was laid.

Nehemiah 9:5 Then the Levites, Oֹוֹיָאֵל (Yahusha), Kadmiel, Bani, Hashabneiah, Sherebiah, Hodiah, Shebaniah and Pethahiah, said, "Arise, Barak (Bless) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) your Aluhym (God) forever and ever! O may Your glorious name be Baruk (Blessed) And exalted above all Barakah (Blessing) and Hallu/Halal (Praise)!"

Psalms 2:11 Worship אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) with reverence And rejoice with trembling.

Psalms 7:17 I will Todah (give thanks) to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) according to His righteousness And will sing Hallu/Halal (Praise) to the name of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) Most High.

Psalms 9:2 I will be glad and exult in You; I will sing Hallu/Halal (Praise) to Your name, O Most High.

Psalms 9:11 Sing Zamar (praises) to אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), who dwells in Zion; Declare among the peoples His deeds.

Psalms 18:3 I call upon אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), who is worthy to be Hallu/Halal (Praised), And I am saved from my enemies.

Psalms 18:49 Therefore I will Todah (give thanks) to You among the nations, O אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), And I will sing Zamar (Praises) to Your name.

Psalms 21:13 Be exalted, O אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), in Your strength; We will sing and Hallu/Halal (Praise) Your power.

Psalms 22:22-23 I will tell of Your name to my brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will

Hallu/Halal (Praise) You. You who fear אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him; All you descendants of Yaqoob (Jacob), glorify Him, And stand in awe of Him, all you descendants of Yasharal.

Psalm 22:25-26 From You comes my Hallu/Halal (Praise) in the great assembly; I shall pay my vows before those who fear Him. The afflicted will eat and be satisfied; Those who seek Him will Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Let your heart live forever!

Psalm 30:4 Sing Hallu/Halal (Praise) to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), you His Righteous ones, And give thanks to His Qadosh (holy) name.

Psalm 30:11-12 You have turned for me my mourning into dancing; You have loosed my sackcloth and girded me with gladness, That my soul may sing Hallu/Halal (Praise) to You and not be silent O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) my Aluhym (God), I will give thanks to You forever.

Psalm 33:1-3 Sing for joy in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), O you righteous ones; Hallu/Halal (Praise) is becoming to the upright. Todah (Give thanks) to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) with the lyre; Sing Zamar (praises) to Him with a harp of ten strings. Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Psalm 34:1-3 I will Barak (Bless) אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) at all times; His Hallu/Halal (Praise) shall continually be in my mouth. My soul will make its boast in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah); The humble will hear it and rejoice. O magnify אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) with me, And let us exalt His name together.

Psalm 40:3 He put a new song in my mouth, a song of Halal (praise) to our Aluhym (God); Many will see and fear And will trust in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah).

Psalm 42:5 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), for I shall again Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him For the help of His presence.

Psalm 42:11 Why are you in despair, O my soul? And why have you become disturbed within me? Hope in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), for I shall yet Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, The help of my countenance and my Aluhym (God).

Psalm 47:6 Sing Zamar (praises) to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), sing Zamar (praises); Sing Zamar (Praises) to our King, sing Zamar (praises).

Psalm 48:1 Great is אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), and greatly to be praised, In the city of our Aluhym (God), His Qadosh (holy) mountain.

Psalm 48:10 As is Your name, O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), So is Your Hallu/Halal (Praise) to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of Righteousness.

Psalm 51:15 O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), open my lips, That my mouth may declare Your Hallu/Halal (Praise).

Psalm 56:4 In אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), whose word I Hallu/Halal (Praise), In אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) I have put my trust; I shall not be afraid What can mere man do to me?

Psalm 57:7 My heart is steadfast, O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), my heart is steadfast; I will sing, yes, I will sing Zamar (praises)!

Psalm 57:9 I will give thanks to You, O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), among the peoples; I will sing Zamar

(praises) to You among the nations.

Psalm 59:17 O my strength, I will sing Zamar (praises) to You; For אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) is my stronghold, the Aluhym (God) who shows me loving kindness.

Psalm 61:8 So I will sing Hallu/Halal (Praise) to Your name forever, That I may pay my vows day by day.

Psalm 63:5 My soul is satisfied as with marrow and fatness, And my mouth offers Zamar (praises) with joyful lips.

Psalm 66:1-2 Shout joyfully to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), all the earth; Sing the esteem (glory) of His name; Make His Hallu/Halal (Praise) glorious.

Psalm 66:4 "All the earth will worship You, And will sing Hallu/Halal (Praises) to You; They will sing Zamar (Praise) to Your name." Selah.

Psalm 67:1-3 אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) be gracious to us and Barak (Bless) us, And cause His face to shine upon us-- Selah. That Your way may be known on the earth, Your salvation among all nations. Let the peoples Hallu/Halal (Praise) You, O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah); Let all the peoples Hallu/Halal (Praise) You.

Psalm 68:4 Sing to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), sing Zamar (Praises) to His name; Lift up a song for Him who rides through the deserts, Whose name is אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), and exult before Him.

Psalm 68:32 Sing to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), O kingdoms of the earth, Sing Zamar (Praises) to אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), Selah.

Psalm 69:30 I will Hallu/Halal (Praise) the name of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) with song And magnify Him with thanksgiving.

Psalm 69:34 Let Shamym (Heavens) and earth Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, The seas and everything that moves in them.

Psalm 71:5-6 For You are my hope; O אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) Aluhym (God), You are my confidence from my youth. By You I have been sustained from my birth; You are He who took me from my mother's womb; My Hallu/Halal (Praise) is continually of You.

Psalm 71:8 My mouth is filled with Your Hallu/Halal (Praise) And with Your esteem (glory) all day long.

Psalm 71:14 But as for me, I will hope continually, And will Hallu/Halal (Praise) You yet more and more.

Psalm 74:21 Let not the oppressed return dishonored; Let the afflicted and needy Hallu/Halal (Praise) Your name.

Psalm 75:9 But as for me, I will declare it forever; I will sing Hallu/Halal (Praises) to the Aluhym (God) of Yaqoob (Jacob).

Psalm 78:4 We will not conceal them from their children, But tell to the generation to come the Hallu/Halal (Praises) of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), And His strength and His wondrous works that He has done.

Psalm 79:13 So we Your people and the sheep of Your pasture Will give thanks to You forever;

To all generations we will tell of Your Hallu/Halal (Praise).

Psalm 89:5 The Shamym (Heavens) will Hallu/Halal (Praise) Your wonders, O אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); Your faithfulness also in the assembly of the Qadosh (holy) ones.

Psalm 96:4 For great is אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) and greatly to be Hallu/Halal (Praise); He is to be feared above all Aluhym (gods).

Psalm 98:4-5 Shout joyfully to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), all the earth; Break forth and sing for joy and sing Hallu/Halal (Praises). Sing Zamar (Praises) to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) with the lyre, With the lyre and the sound of melody.

Psalm 99:3 Let them Hallu/Halal (Praise) Your great and awesome name; Qadosh (Holy) is He.

Psalm 102:18 This will be written for the generation to come, That a people yet to be created may Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּהּ (Yahuah).

Psalm 104:33 I will sing to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) as long as I live; I will sing Hallu/Halal (Praise) to my Aluhym (God) while I have my being.

Psalm 104:35 Let sinners be consumed from the earth And let the wicked be no more Barak (Bless) אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), O my soul Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)!

Psalm 105:2 Sing to Him, sing Zamar (Praises) to Him; Speak of all His wonders.

Psalm 106:1 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)! Oh give thanks to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), for He is good; For His loving kindness is everlasting.

Psalm 106:47-48 Save us, O אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) our Aluhym (God), And gather us from among the nations, To give thanks to Your Qadosh (holy) name And glory in Your Hallu/Halal (Praise). Baruk (Blessed) be אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), the Aluhym (God) of Yasharal, From everlasting even to everlasting. And let all the people say, "Aman." Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)!

Psalm 107:32 Let them extol Him also in the congregation of the people, And Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him at the seat of the elders.

Psalm 108:1 My heart is steadfast, O אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); I will sing, I will sing Zamar (Praises), even with my soul.

Psalm 108:3 I will Todah (give thanks) to You, O אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), among the peoples, And I will sing Zamar (Praises) to You among the nations.

Psalm 109:30 With my mouth I will give thanks abundantly to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah); And in the midst of many I will Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him.

Psalm 111:1 Praise אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)! I will give thanks to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) with all my heart, In the company of the upright and in the assembly.

Psalm 111:10 The fear (Reverence) of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) is the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do His commandments; His Hallu/Halal (Praise) endures forever.

Psalm 112:1 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)! How Baruk (Blessed) is the man who fears אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), Who greatly delights in His Commandments.

Psalm 113:1 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Hallu/Halal (Praise), O servants of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), Hallu/Halal (Praise) the name of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah).

Psalm 113:3 From the rising of the sun to its setting, The name of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) is to be Hallu/Halal (Praise).

Psalm 115:17-18 The dead do not Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), Nor do any who go down into silence; But as for us, we will Barak (Bless) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) From this time forth and forever. Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)!

Psalm 117:1-2 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), all nations; Laud Him, all peoples! For His loving kindness is great toward us, And the truth of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) is everlasting. Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)!

Psalm 119:164 Seven (7) times a day I Hallu/Halal (Praise) You, Because of Your Righteous ordinances.

Psalm 119:171 Let my lips utter Hallu/Halal (Praise), For You teach me Your statutes.

Psalm 119:175 Let my soul live that it may Hallu/Halal (Praise) You, And let Your ordinances help me.

Psalm 135:1-3 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Hallu/Halal (Praise) the Name of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah); Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, O servants of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), You who stand in the house of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), In the courts of the house of our Aluhym (God)! Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), for אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) is good; Sing Zamar (Praises) to His Name, for it is lovely.

Psalm 135:21 Baruk (Blessed) be אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) from Zion, Who dwells in Yarusalym (Jerusalem). Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)!

Psalm 145:1-4 I will extol You, my Aluhym (God), O King, And I will Barak (Bless) Your name forever and ever. Every day I will Barak (Bless) You, And I will Hallu/Halal (Praise) Your name forever and ever. Great is אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), and highly to be Hallu/Halal (Praised), And His greatness is unsearchable.

Psalm 145:21 My mouth will speak the Halal (Praise) of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), And all flesh will Barak (Bless) His Qadosh (Holy) name forever and ever.

Psalm 146:1-2 Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), O my soul! I will Halal (praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) while I live; I will sing praises to my Aluhym (God) while I have my being.

Psalm 146:10 אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) will reign forever, Your Aluhym (God), O Zion, to all generations. Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)!

Psalm 147:1 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! For it is good to sing Zamar (Praises) to our Aluhym (God); For it is pleasant and Hallu/Halal (Praise) is becoming.

Psalm 148:1-5 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah)! Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) from the Shamym (Heavens); Halal (Praise) Him in the heights! Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, all His Malkym (Angels); Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, all His hosts! Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, Sun and Moon; Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him, all Stars of light!

Psalm 148:7 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) from the earth, Sea monsters and all deeps;

Psalm 148:13-14 Let them Hallu/Halal (Praise) the Name of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), For His Name alone is exalted; His esteem (glory) is above earth and Shamym (Heavens). And He has lifted up a horn for His people, Hallu/Halal (Praise) for all His righteous ones; Even for the sons of Yasharal (Israel), a people near to Him. Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)!

Psalm 149:1 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)! Sing to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) a new song, And His Hallu/Halal (Praise) in the congregation of the Righteous ones.

Psalm 149:3 Let them Hallu/Halal (Praise) His name with dancing; Let them sing Zamar (praises) to Him with timbrel and lyre.

Psalm 149:6 Let the high Hallu/Halal (Praise) of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) be in their mouth, And a two-edged sword in their hand,

Psalm 150:1-6 Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)! Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) in His sanctuary; Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him in His mighty expanse. Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him for His mighty deeds; Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him according to His excellent greatness. Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him with trumpet sound; Hallu/Halal (Praise) Him with harp and lyre.

Isaiah 25:1 O אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), You are my Aluhym (God); I will exalt You, I will Todah (give thanks) to Your name; For You have worked wonders, Plans formed long ago, with perfect faithfulness.

Isaiah 42:8 "I am אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), that is My Name; I will not give My esteem (glory) to another, Nor My Hallu/Halal (Praise) to graven images.

Isaiah 42:10 Sing to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) a new song, Sing His Hallu/Halal (Praise) from the end of the earth! You who go down to the sea, and all that is in it You islands, and those who dwell on them.

Isaiah 43:21 "The people whom I formed for Myself Will declare My Hallu/Halal (Praise).

Jeremiah 20:13 Sing to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), Hallu/Halal (Praise) אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)! For He has delivered the soul of the needy one From the hand of evildoers.

Jeremiah 31:7 For this says אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), "Sing aloud with gladness for Yaqoob (Jacob), And shout among the chief of the nations; Proclaim, give Halal (praise) and say, 'O אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), save Your people, The remnant of Yasharal.'

Joel 2:26 "You will have plenty to eat and be satisfied And Hallu/Halal (Praise) the name of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) your Aluhym (God), Who has dealt wondrously with you; Then My people will never be put to shame.

Acts 16:25-26 But about midnight Shaul (Paul) and Silas were praying and singing hymns of Hallu/Halal (Praise) to אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), and the prisoners were listening to them; and suddenly there came a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison house were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened.

Revelation 19:5-6 And a voice came from the throne, saying, "Give Hallu/Halal (Praise) to our Aluhym (God), all you His bond-servants, you who fear Him, the small and the great." Then I heard something like the voice of a great multitude and like the sound of many waters and like

the sound of mighty peals of thunder, saying, "HalluYah! For **יהוה** (Yahuah) our Aluhym (God), the Almighty, reigns.
