

Promises of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)

א מ ד (Amr), אָמַר omer 562: Promise, Speech, Thing, Word

א Aleph = Strong, Power, Leader

מ Mem = Chaos, Mighty, Blood+

א Resh = First (1st), Top, Beginning

Our Strong, Power, Leader in Chaos is Mighty through his Blood, being the First (1st), places him at the Top, as the head, the beginning, the Promise, the Promised One (1), The WORD.

The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. The Scripture does not say, “and to seeds,” meaning many, but “and to your seed,” meaning One, who is Mashiach. **Galatians 3:16**

Greek

Epaggelia (pronounced ep-ang-el-ee'-ah) 1860 from 1861; an announcement (for information, assent or pledge; especially a divine assurance of good):--message, promise.

WHAT ARE THE PROMISES OF אַיָּהּ (YAHUAH)? HOW CERTAIN ARE THE PROMISES OF אַיָּהּ (YAHUAH)?

Shaul (Paul), when writing about the promises of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) to Abraham: "For the promise that he should be heir of the world, was not to Abraham or his seed through the Turah (Law), but through the righteousness of Amunah (Faith) . . . therefore it is of Amunah (Faith), that it might be by Chen (grace); to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed" **Romans 4:13, 16**. אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)'s promise to Abraham was first (1st) spelled out in **Genesis Chapter 12**. It was repeated in Chapter **22:18** reads: "And in your seed shall all the nations of the earth be Baruk (Blessed); because you have obeyed my voice".

Now a promise is of no more value than is the ability of the one who makes it to carry it out. It also includes willingness to do so. אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) did fulfill it out with Abraham. Shaul (Paul) points out in **Galatians 3:16**, that it was through Mashiach, אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) intended to fulfill the promise to Abraham. Also in **Acts 13:32-33**, "And we declare unto you glad tidings how that the promise which was made unto the fathers, אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) has fulfilled the same unto us their children, in that he has raised up **אָוֶשָׁהּ (Yahusha)** again."

אָוֶשָׁהּ (Yahusha)'s life, while living on earth, was shaped by his trust in the power of the promises of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). When **אָוֶשָׁהּ (Yahusha)** said: "I am that bread of life", **John 6:48**, "I am the light of the world", **John 8:12**, "I am the resurrection and the life." **John 11:25**, He did so fully realizing that He had been empowered with this right by the Father who had promised to raise Him from Sheol (the grave). There were more than 500 brethren at one (1) time who bore witness to the fulfillment of this promise according to **I Corinthians 15:1-6**.

PROMISES FROM אַיָּהּ (YAHUAH)

You will not lack anything that is needed. "Oh, fear אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), you His chosen believers! there is no want to those who fear Him. The young lions lack and suffer hunger; but those who seek אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) shall not lack any good thing." **Psalms 34:9-10**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) will take care of your day-to-day needs. “Therefore do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek (1st) first the kingdom of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you. Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.” **Matthew 6:31-34**

As you meditate on אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)’s word your way will be prosperous. "This Books of the Turah (Law) shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make ל your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.” **Joshua 1:8**

"Bring ל all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and try Me now in this,” says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) of hosts, “If I will not open for you ל the windows of the Shamyim (heavens) and pour out for you such Barakah (blessing) that there will not be room enough to receive it. “And I will rebuke the devourer for your sake, so that he will not destroy ל the fruit of your ground, nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field,” says אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Sabaoth (hosts);” **Malachi 3:10-11**

"And my Aluhym shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by **וְיֵשׁוּעָה** (Yahusha) HaMashiach.” **Philippians 4:19**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) gave the best He had by giving us His only Son. "He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?" **Romans 8:32**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) does not hold back anything that is for your benefit or good. "For אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhym is our Light and our Protector. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) bestows favor and honor. No good thing does he withhold from those who walk uprightly." **Psalms 84:11**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised to Barak (Bless) Abraham and, through his descendants, the whole world **Genesis 12:2–3**. This promise, called the Abrahamic Covenant, pointed to the coming Mashaich for whom Abraham looked. **John 8:56**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised Yasharal to be their Aluhym and make them His people **Leviticus 26:12–13**. Tanakh (Old Testament) history is teeming with examples of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) fulfilling this promise.

But if from thence you shall seek ל אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) Aluhayka (your Aluhym), you shall find him, if you seek him with all your heart and with all your soul. **Deuteronomy 4:29**.

“Our Aluhym is near us whenever we pray to him” **Deuteronomy 4:7**.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised protection for His children, he guards their ל souls. **Psalms 121**. He was the vigilant watchman over all Yasharal,

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised that His love will never fail **1 Chronicles 16:34**. He is faithful in every way.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised Yasharal that their sin could be forgiven, their prosperity restored, and their nation healed **2 Chronicles 7:14**. Repentance opened the road to fellowship and Barakah (Blessing).

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah), under the terms of the Mosaic Covenant, promised prosperity to Yasharal for obedience and destruction for disobedience **Deuteronomy 30:15–18**. Unfortunately, Yasharal eventually chose to disobey, and the nation was destroyed by Assyria and Babylon.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised Barakah (Blessing) for all who will delight themselves in His Word **Psalms 1:1–3**. Simple Amunah (Faith) has its rewards. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised salvation to all who believe in His Son **Romans 1:16–17**. There is no greater Barakah (Blessing) than the free gift of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah)'s salvation.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised comfort in our trials **2 Corinthians 1:3–4**. He has a plan, and one day we will be able to share the comfort we receive.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised new life in Messiah **2 Corinthians 5:17**. Salvation is the beginning of a brand-new existence.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised every spiritual Barakah (blessing) in Mashiach **Ephesians 1:3**. Whereas, in the Tanakh (Old Testament), Yasharal had the promise of physical Barakah (Blessing), believers today have been promised spiritual Barakah (Blessings) "in the heavenly realms." Our inheritance is reserved for us **1 Peter 1:4**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised to finish the work He started in us **Philippians 1:6**. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) does nothing in half measures. He started the work in us and He will complete it.

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised Shalum (peace) when we pray **Philippians 4:6–7**. His Shalum (peace) is protection. It will "guard your hearts and your minds in Mashiach."

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promised to supply our needs (**Matthew 6:33; Philippians 4:19**). Not that we get everything we want, but our needs will be taken care of. We are more valuable than the birds, and our Heavenly Father feeds them **Matthew 6:26**.

SEVEN (7) THINGS THAT CAN BE SAID ABOUT אֱלֹהִים (YAHUAH)'S PROMISES

1. He has promised to supply every need we have. Scripture says: "But my Aluhym shall supply all your need according to his riches in honor by **וְיָשׁוּעָה** (Yahusha) HaMashiach". **Philippians 4:19**. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has obligated Himself only to the extent of our needs. That would include food, clothing, shelter, companionship, love, and salvation thru **וְיָשׁוּעָה** (Yahusha) HaMashiach.
2. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has promised that His chen/charis (grace) is sufficient for us. (**II Corinthians 12:9**). in fact, He has made provision for our salvation by His chen/charis (grace) through Amunah (Faith). **Ephesians 2:8**. It is through an obedient Amunah (Faith) that we have access into the chen/charis (grace) of אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) according to **Romans 5:2**.
3. אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has promised that His children will not be overtaken with temptation. Instead, He assures us that a way of escape will be provided. This promise is recorded in **I Corinthians 10:13**. Jude wrote: "Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his honor with exceeding joy" (**Jude 1:24**). Darius, King of the Medes, said to Daniel, "Your Aluhym whom you serve continually, he will deliver you" **Daniel 6:16**. He did deliver Daniel from the den of lions.

4. **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) has promised us victory over death. He (1st) first resurrected **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) by way of assuring our resurrection. Kepha (Peter) said: "This **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) has **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) raised up, whereof we are all witnesses" **Acts 2:32**. Shaul (Paul) wrote to the Corinthians: "For I delivered unto you first (1st) of all that which I also received, how that Mashiach died for our sins according to the scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third (3rd) day according to the scriptures" **I Corinthians 15:3,4**. Later on he adds: "but thanks be to **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah), which gives us the victory through our Adon, **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach" **I Corinthians 15:57**.

5. **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) has promised that all things work together for good to those who love and serve Him faithfully **Romans 8:28**.

It may be difficult for us to see and understand how this is accomplished at times, but **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) has promised it, and He will deliver.

6. **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) has promised that those who believe in **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach and are immersed (baptized) for the forgiveness of sins will be saved. **Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38**.

7. **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah) has promised His people eternal life **John 10:27-28**.

PROMISES FROM וְיֵשׁוּעַ (YAHUSHA)

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) promised rest **Matthew 11:28–30**. Burdens are lifted.

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) promised abundant life to those who follow Him **John 10:10**.

Following **וְיֵשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha) brings us more spiritual fulfillment than we could have anticipated.

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) promised eternal life to those who trust Him **John 4:14**. The Good Shepherd also promised to hold us securely: "No one will snatch them out of my hand" **John 10:28**.

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) promised His disciples power from on high **Acts 1:8**. Through this power, they "turned the world upside down" **Acts 17:6**.

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) promised that He will return for those that believe in him, those who love him and trust in him **John 14:2–3**. Then we will be with Him always.

PROMISES OF A SECOND (2ND) COMING AND RESURRECTION

Scripture promises that the dead will live again. "Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation." **John 5:28-29**

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) has promised that He will come again. "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also." **John 14:2-3**

וְיֵשׁוּעַ (Yahusha) promises that the dead will be raised again. "For this we say to you by the word of **אֵלֹהִים** (Yahuah), that we who are alive and remain until the coming of **וְיֵשׁוּעַ**

(Yahusha) will by no means precede those who are asleep. For **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) Himself will descend from the Shamyim (Heavens) with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of **AYAZL** (Yahuah). And the dead in Messiah will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) in the air. And thus we shall always be with **OWYAZL** (Yahusha). Therefore comfort one another with these words." **1 Thessalonians 4:15-18**

PROMISES A NEW HEART AND FORGIVENESS

AYAZL (Yahuah) has promised us new hearts and desires. I will give you a new heart and put a new Ruch (spirit) within you; I will take the heart of stone out of your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. **Ezekiel 36:26**

AYAZL (Yahuah) has promised forgiveness. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." **1 John 1:9**

AYAZL (Yahuah) promises our sins will be far removed from us. "As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us." **Psalms 103:12**

"He will again have compassion on us, and will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea." **Micah 7:19**

If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from the Shamyim (heavens), and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. **2 Chronicles 7:14**

You have forgiven the iniquity of your people, you have covered all their sin. Selah. **Psalms 85:2**

For you, **AYAZL** (Yahuah), are good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon you. **Psalms 86:5**

And when you stand praying, forgive, if you have ought against any: that your Father also which is in the Shamyim (heavens) may forgive you your trespasses. **Mark 11:25**

And be kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as **AYAZL** (Yahuah) for Mashiach's sake has forgiven you. **Ephesians 4:32**

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. **1 John 1:9**

I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, your transgressions, and, as a cloud, your sins: return unto me; for I have redeemed you. **Isaiah 44:22**

And I will deliver you out of the hand of the wicked, and I will redeem you out of the hand of the terrible. **Jeremiah 15:21**

For **AYAZL** (Yahuah) so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. **John 3:16**

He that believes on the Son has everlasting life: and he that believes not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) abides on him. **John 3:36**

For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) is eternal life through **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) our Adon. **Romans 6:23**

For I am persuaded, that neither death, nor life, nor Malakym (angels), nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), which is in OʷYָאֵל (Yahusha) our Adon. **Romans 8:38-39**

That if you shall confess with your mouth the Adon, OʷYָאֵל (Yahusha) HaMashiach, and shall believe in your heart that אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah) has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved. For with the heart man believes unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. **Romans 10:9-10**

To the Halal (praise) of the esteem (glory) of his chen (grace), wherein he has made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his chen (grace); **Ephesians 1:6-7**

Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as you have: for he has said, I will never leave you, nor forsake you. **Hebrews 13:5**

He that overcomes, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his Malakym (angels). **Revelation 3:5**

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me. **Revelation 3:20**

PROMISES OF THE RUCH AHQUDESH

He has promised the fruit of the Ruch (Spirit). "But the fruit of the Ruch (Spirit) is Aahbah (love), joy, Shalum (peace), longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law." **Galatians 5:22-23**

We are promised the Ruch AhQudesh. "If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Ruch AhQudesh to those who ask Him!" **Luke 11:13**

The Ruch AhQudesh will guide you and show you the truth. "...When he, the Ruch (Spirit) of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come." **John 16:13**

Turn at my reproof: behold, I will pour out my Ruch (spirit) unto you, I will make known my words unto you. **Proverbs 1:23**

And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and you shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. For every one that asks receives; and he that seeks finds; and to him that knocks it shall be opened. If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Ruch AhQudesh to them that ask him? **Luke 11:9-13**

And whatsoever you shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified (esteemed) in the Son. If you shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. If you love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that

he may abide with you for ever; **John 14:13-16**

But you shall receive power, after that the Ruch AhQudesh is come upon you: and you shall be witnesses unto me both in Yaruslym, and in all Yahudah, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. **Acts 1:8**

And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), I will pour out of my Ruch (Spirit) upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Ruch (Spirit); and they shall prophesy: **Acts 2:17-18**

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of **וַיְהוָה** (Yahusha) HaMashiach for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Ruch AhQudesh. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) our Aluhym) shall call. **Acts 2:38-39**

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Ruch (Spirit) in the inner man; That Mashiach may dwell in your hearts by Amunah (Faith); that you, being rooted and grounded in Aahbah (love), May be able to comprehend with all chosen believers what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; And to know the love of Mashaich, which passes knowledge, that you might be filled with all the fullness of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah). **Ephesians 3:16-19**

PROMISES OF WISDOM AND GUIDANCE

Wisdom is one of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah)'s promises. "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him." **James 1:5**

אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) gives wisdom and guides us. "I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you shall go: I will guide you with mine eye." **Psalms 32:8**

Don't look to yourself for wisdom. "Trust in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) and depart from evil." **Proverbs 3:5-7**

אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) promises to guide you on His pathway. "And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, This is the way, walk in it, when you turn to the right hand, and when you turn to the left." **Isaiah 30:21**

And, behold, I am with you, and will keep you in all places wherever you go, and will bring you again into this land; for I will not leave you, until I have done that which I have spoken to thee of. **Genesis 28:15**

Have not I commanded you? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be dismayed: for אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluhym is with you where ever you go. **Joshua 1:9**

What man is he that fears אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah)? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. **Psalms 25:12**

Trust in אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) with all your heart; and lean not unto your own understanding. In all

your ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct your paths. **Proverbs 3:5-6**

And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. **Isaiah 65:24**

Call unto me, and I will answer you, and shew you great and mighty things, which you do not know. **Jeremiah 33:3**

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him. - **James 1:5**

PROMISES TO THE FAMILY

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) will save your children. "For I will contend with him who contends with you, and I will save your children." **Isaiah 49:25**

Children are a Barakah (blessing) from **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah). "Behold, children are a heritage from **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), the fruit of the womb is a reward. Like arrows in the hand of a warrior, so are the children of one's youth. Happy is the man who has his quiver full of them; They shall not be ashamed, but shall speak with their enemies in the gate." **Psalms 119:3-5**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) calls husbands and wives to a mutually beneficial marriages. "Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband." **1 Corinthians 7:3**

וַיְהִי (Yahusha) gave all for the chosen believers, we should do likewise. "Husbands, love your wives, just as Messiah also loved the chosen believers and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious body of believers, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be Qadosh (holy) and without blemish. 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as **וַיְהִי** (Yahusha) does the chosen believers. For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Messiah and the chosen believers. Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband." **Ephesians 5:25-33**

Then **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) Aluhym said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him . **Genesis 2:18**

Delight yourself also in **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah): and he shall give you the desires of your heart. **Psalms 37:4**

Whosoever finds a wife finds a good thing, and obtains favor of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah). **Proverbs 18:22**

For your Maker is your husband; **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) of hosts is his name; and your Redeemer the Qadosh (Holy) One of Yasharal; The Aluhym) of the whole earth shall he be called. **Isaiah 54:5**

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), thoughts of Shalum (peace), and not of evil, to give you an expected end. - **Jeremiah 29:11**

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he hears us: **1 John 5:14**

Honor your father and thy mother: that your days may be long upon the land which **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) your Aluhym gives you. **Exodus 20:12**

But the mercy (compassion) of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; **Psalms 103:17**

Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. **Proverbs 22:6**

For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my Ruch (Spirit) upon your seed, and my Barakah (Blessing) upon your offspring: **Isaiah 44:3**

But this is what **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) says, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contends with you, and I will save your children. **Isaiah 49:25**

And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers... **Malachi 4:6**

PROMISES OF SHALUM (PEACE)

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has promised Shalum (Peace). "You will keep him in perfect Shalum (Peace), Whose mind is stayed on You, because he trusts in You." **Isaiah 26:3**

You don't need to worry. "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah)." **Philippians 4:6**

Scripture promises Shalum (Peace) as we live according to its principles. "Great Shalum (peace) have those who love Your Turah (law), And nothing causes them to stumble." **Psalms 119:165**

PROMISES HELP IN OVERCOMING TEMPTATION

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has promised victory over temptations. "No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it." **1 Corinthians 10:13**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) promises HaSatan (the devil) will flee if we submit and draw near to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) and resist HaSatan. "Therefore submit to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah). Resist HaSatan (the devil) and he will flee from you. Draw near to **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Lament and mourn and weep! Let your laughter be turned to mourning and your joy to gloom. Humble yourselves in the sight of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), and He will lift you up." **James 4:7-10**

וַיִּשָׁע (Yahusha) promises to help us through our temptations. "For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted." **Hebrews 2:18**

PROMISES OF DELIVERANCE AND PROTECTION

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has promised protection from harm and danger. "He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler. You shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the

pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday." **Psalm 91:4-6**

אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah)'s promises provide safety."The name of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe." **Proverbs 18:10**

אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) walks with us in our troubles."Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me; you will stretch out Your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and Your right hand will save me." **Psalm 138:7**

The Malakym (angel) of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) encamps round about them that fear him, and deliver them. **Psalms 34:7**

Because he has set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known my name. **Psalms 91:14**

If you have Amunah (Faith) as a grain of mustard seed, you shall say unto this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move, and nothing will be impossible for you. **Matthew 17:18-21**

The Ruch (Spirit) of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the good news of the Messiah to the poor; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, **Luke 4:17-18**

אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. And they that know your name will put their trust in you: for you, אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), have not forsaken them that seek you. **Psalms 9:9-10**

The righteous cry, and אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles. **Psalms 34:17**

Then they cried unto אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses. He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder. Oh that men would Halal (praise) אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! For he has broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder. **Psalms 107:13-16**

Heaviness in the heart of man makes it stoop: but a good word makes it glad. **Proverbs 12:25**

Fear not; for I am with you: be not dismayed; for I am your Aluhym: I will strengthen you; yes, I will help you; yes, I will uphold you with the right hand of my righteousness. **Isaiah 41:10**

For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from you, neither shall the covenant of my Shalum (Peace) be removed, says אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) that has mercy (compassion) on you. **Isaiah 54:10**

It is of אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah)'s mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassion's fail not. They are new every morning: great is your faithfulness. **Lamentations 3:22-23**

Chen/charis (Grace) be to you and Shalum (Peace) from אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah) our Father, and from the Adon **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach. Baruak (Blessed) be אֱלֹהֵינוּ (Yahuah), even the Father of our Adon **אֱלֹהֵינוּ** (Yahusha) HaMashiach, the Father of mercies (compassion), and

the Aluhym of all comfort; Who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted by **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah). **2 Corinthians 1:2-4**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) has promised deliverance from fear. "I sought **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears. **Psalm 34:4**

We don't need to be afraid or fearful. "Shalum (Peace) I leave with you, My Shalum Peace) I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." **John 14:27**

Fear is removed through Righteous love. "There is no fear in Aahbah (love); but perfect Aahbah (love) casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been made perfect in Aahbah (love). We love Him because He first loved us." **1 John 4:18**

PROMISES TO END SUFFERING AND PAIN

He has promised an end to death, sorrow, and pain. "And **וְיֵשׁוּעָא** (Yahusha) will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away." **Revelation 21:4**

And call upon me in the day of trouble: I will deliver you, and you shall glorify me. **Psalms 50:15**

Is not this the fast that I have chosen to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? **Isaiah 58:6**

The Ruach (Spirit) of **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) Aluhym is upon me; because **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah) has anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; **Isaiah 61:1**

If the Son therefore shall make you free, you shall be free indeed. **John 8:36**

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in **וְיֵשׁוּעָא** (Yahusha) HaMashiach, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Ruch (Spirit). **Romans 8:1**

Therefore if any man be in Mashiach, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. **2 Corinthians 5:17**

This I say then, Walk in the Ruch (Spirit), and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. **Galatians 5:16**

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) FIGHTS FOR YOU

אֱלֹהִים (Yahuah) shall fight for you, and you shall hold your Shalum (Peace). **Exodus 14:14**

And **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), it is he that does go before you; he will be with you, he will not fail you, neither forsake you: do not fear, neither be dismayed. **Deuteronomy 31:8**

I will call upon **אֱלֹהִים** (Yahuah), who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from my enemies. **Psalms 18:3**

Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for you are with me; your rod and your staff they comfort me. **Psalms 23:4**

יְהוָה (Yahuah) is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? יְהוָה (Yahuah) is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? **Psalms 27:1**

For I יְהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluhym will hold your right hand, saying unto you, Fear not; I will help you. **Isaiah 41:13**

When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you: when you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon you. **Isaiah 43:2**

PROMISES OF BARAKAH (BLESSINGS)

יְהוָה (Yahuah) shall open unto you his good treasure, the Shamym (Heavens) to give the rain unto your land in his season, and to Barak (Bless) all the work of your hand: and you shall lend unto many nations, and you shall not borrow. **Deuteronomy 28:12**

He becomes poor that deals with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent makes rich. **Proverbs 10:4**

Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathers by labor shall increase. **Proverbs 13:11**

Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knows that you have need of all these things. But seek first the kingdom of יְהוָה (Yahuah), and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. **Matthew 6:31-33**

But my Aluhym shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by **וְיֵשׁוּעָה** (Yahusha). **Philippians 4:19**

PROMISES OF HEALING

יְהוָה (Yahuah) promises health to us if we listen. "If you diligently heed the voice of יְהוָה (Yahuah) your Aluhym and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Mitsryim (Egyptians). For I am יְהוָה (Yahuah) your Rapha (your Healer)." **Exodus 15:26**

יְהוָה (Yahuah) heals us and forgives us. "Barak (Bless) יְהוָה (Yahuah), O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things; so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. **Psalms 103:2-5**

But they that wait upon יְהוָה (Yahuah) shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. **Isaiah 40:31**

But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our Shalum (Peace) was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. **Isaiah 53:5**

Heal me, O יְהוָה (Yahuah), and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for you are my Halal (praise). **Jeremiah 17:14**

We have the promise of health and healing."For I will restore health to you and heal you of

your wounds,' says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)" **Jeremiah 30:17**

But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and you shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall. **Malachi 4:2**

Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the chosen believers; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): And the prayer of Amunah (Faith) shall save the sick, and אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) shall raise him up; and if he has committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. **James 5:14-15**

PROMISES TO STRENGTHEN US TO DO אַיָּהּ (YAHUAH)'S WILL

Wait on אַיָּהּ (Yahuah): be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart: wait, I say, on אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). **Psalms 27:14**

No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah), and their righteousness is of me, says אַיָּהּ (Yahuah). **Isaiah 54:17**

For which cause us to not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, works for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of esteem (glory); While we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal; but the things which are not seen are eternal. **2 Corinthians 4:16-18**

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we do not faint. **Galatians 6:9**

I can do all things through Mashiach which strengthens me. **Philippians 4:13**

For all the promises of אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) find their Yes in him. That is why it is through him that we utter our Amen to אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) for his esteem and honor.

Thankfully, there is One who keeps His word and never changes. As **Hebrews 10:23** tells us, "אַיָּהּ (Yahuah) who promised is faithful." If we trust אַיָּהּ (Yahuah)'s promises with a right Ruch (spirit) and pure motives, we will honor Him and grow in intimacy with our loving Father. Trust his Promises for you, because he is faithful!
