

# The Great and Dreadful Day of Yahuah

**Luke 21:25-30** “Then there will be signs in the sun, moon, and stars; and there will be anguish on the earth among nations bewildered by the roaring sea and waves. **26** People will faint from fear and expectation of the things that are coming on the world, because the celestial powers will be shaken. **27** Then they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. **28** But when these things begin to take place, stand up and lift up your heads, because your redemption is near!

**Matthew 24:21** For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been from the beginning of the world until now, no, and never will be. And if those days had not been cut short, no human being would be saved. But for the sake of the elect those days will be cut short.

**Ezekiel 38:1-9** The word of אַיָּהוּא (Yahuah) came to me: **2** “Son of man, set your face toward Gog, of the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him<sup>3</sup> and say, Thus says אַיָּהוּא (Yahuah) Aloah (God): Behold, I am against you, O Gog, chief prince of Meshech and Tubal. **4** And I will turn you about and put hooks into your jaws, and I will bring you out, and all your army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed in full armor, a great host, all of them with buckler and shield, wielding swords. **5** Persia, Cush, and Put are with them, all of them with shield and helmet; **6** Gomer and all his hordes; Beth-togarmah from the uttermost parts of the north with all his hordes—many peoples are with you. **7** “Be ready and keep ready, you and all your hosts that are assembled about you, and be a guard for them. **8** After many days you will be mustered. In the latter years you will go against the land that is restored from war, the land whose people were gathered from many peoples upon the mountains of Israel, which had been a continual waste. Its people were brought out from the peoples and now dwell securely, all of them. **9** You will advance, coming on like a storm. You will be like a cloud covering the land, you and all your hordes, and many peoples with you.

**Matthew 24:29-30** “Immediately after the tribulation of those days: The sun will be darkened, and the moon will not shed its light; the stars will fall from the Heavens, and the celestial powers will be shaken.**30** “Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in the sky, and then all the peoples of the earth will mourn; and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

**Matthew 16:27-28** For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the esteem (glory) of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done. Truly, I say to you, there are some standing here who will not taste death until they see the Son of Man coming in his kingdom.”

**Revelation 22:12** “Behold, I am coming soon, bringing my recompense with me, to repay everyone for what he has done.

**1 Thessalonians 4:16** For **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), and the dead in Messiah will rise first.

**Isaiah 26:19** Your dead will live; their bodies will rise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in the dust! For you will be covered with the morning dew, and the earth will bring out the departed spirits.

**Matthew 24:36** “But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father.

**2 Peter 3:10** But the day of **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything done in it will be laid bare.

**John 3:19-21** And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his works should be exposed. But whoever does what is true comes to the light, so that it may be clearly seen that his works have been carried out in **AYAZL** (Yahuah).”

**2 Peter 3:3-7** Knowing this first of all, that scoffers will come in the last days with scoffing, following their own sinful desires. They will say, “Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation.” For they deliberately overlook this fact, that the heavens existed long ago, and the earth was formed out of water and through water by the word of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), and that by means of these the world that then existed was deluged with water and perished. But by the same word the heavens and earth that now exist are stored up for fire, being kept until the day of judgment and destruction of the ungodly.

**Revelation 3:1-43** “To the angel of the Hebraic Community in Sardis, write: ‘Here is the message from the one who has the sevenfold Spirit of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) and the seven stars: “I know what you are doing — you have a reputation for being alive, but in fact you are dead! **2** Wake up, and strengthen what remains, before it dies too! For I have found what you are doing incomplete in the sight of my Alahym (God). **3** So remember what you received and heard, and obey it, and turn from your sin! For if you don’t wake up, I will come like a thief; and you don’t know at what moment I will come upon you. **4** Nevertheless, you do have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes; and they will walk with me, clothed in white, because they are worthy.

**Zechariah 14:1-7** Look, a day is coming for **AYAZL** (Yahuah) when your plunder, [Yerushalayim], will be divided right there within you. **2** “For I will gather all the nations against Yerushalayim for war. The city will be taken, the houses will be rifled, the women will be raped, and half the city will go into exile; but the rest of the people will not be cut off from the city.” **3** Then **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will go out and fight against

those nations, fighting as on a day of battle. **4** On that day his feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, which lies to the east of Yerushalayim; and the Mount of Olives will be split in half from east to west, to make a huge valley. Half of the mountain will move toward the north, and half of it toward the south. **5** You will flee to the valley in the mountains, for the valley in the mountains will reach to Atzel. You will flee, just as you fled before the earthquake in the days of ‘Uziah king of Yahudah. Then **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) my Aloah (God) will come to you with all the Kadosh (holy) ones.

**Romans 2:16** On that day when, according to my good news, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) judges the secrets of men by **וַיְהוָה** (Yahusha) HaMashiach.

**Matthew 12:36-41** I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

**Isaiah 11:4** But with righteousness he shall judge the poor, and decide with equity for the meek of the earth; and he shall strike the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips he shall kill the wicked.

**2 Peter 2:4-10** For **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) did not spare the angels who sinned; on the contrary, he put them in gloomy dungeons lower than She’ol to be held for judgment. **5** And he did not spare the ancient world; on the contrary, he preserved Noah, a herald of righteousness, with seven others, and brought the Flood upon a world of ungodly people. **6** And he condemned the cities of Sodom and ‘Amora, reducing them to ashes and ruin, as a warning to those in the future who would live ungodly lives; **7** but he rescued Lot, a righteous man who was distressed by the debauchery of those unprincipled people; **8** for the wicked deeds which that righteous man saw and heard, as he lived among them, tormented his righteous heart day after day. **9** So **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) knows how to rescue the godly from trials and how to hold the wicked until the Day of Judgment while continuing to punish them, **10** especially those who follow their old natures in lust for filth and who despise authority.

**Acts 17:30-31** The times of ignorance **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) overlooked, but now he commands all people everywhere to repent, because he has fixed a day on which he will judge the world in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed; and of this he has given assurance to all by raising him from the dead.”

**Matthew 7:21-23** “Not everyone who says to me, ‘Master (Lord), Master (Lord),’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. **22** On that day many will say to me, ‘Master (Lord), Master (Lord), did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?’ **23** And then will I declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness (Breakers of the Torah/The Commandments).

**Matthew 16:24-27** Then **וַיְהוָה** (Yahusha) told his disciples, “If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For whoever would

save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul? For the Son of Man is going to come with his angels in the esteem (glory) of his Father, and then he will repay each person according to what he has done.

**Joel 2:29-32** Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out my Spirit. “And I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and columns of smoke. The sun shall be turned to darkness, and the moon to blood, before the great and awesome day of **אֲיָאֵל** (Yahuah) comes. And it shall come to pass that everyone who calls on the name of **אֲיָאֵל** (Yahuah) shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be those who escape, as **אֲיָאֵל** (Yahuah) has said, and among the survivors shall be those whom **אֲיָאֵל** (Yahuah) calls.

**1 Peter 4:17-19** For it is time for judgment to begin at the household of **אֲיָאֵל** (Yahuah); and if it begins with us, what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the good news of **וְיָשׁוּעָא** (Yahusha)? And “If the righteous is scarcely saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner?” Therefore let those who suffer according to **אֲיָאֵל** (Yahuah)'s will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.

**Hebrews 4:13** And no creature is hidden from his sight, but all are naked and exposed to the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

**2 Corinthians 5:10** For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Messiah, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

**John 6:40** For this is the will of My Father: that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

**Luke 13:23-30** And someone said to him, “Master (Lord), will those who are saved be few?” And he said to them, “Strive to enter through the narrow door. For many, I tell you, will seek to enter and will not be able. When once the master of the house has risen and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and to knock at the door, saying, ‘Master (Lord), open to us,’ then he will answer you, ‘I do not know where you come from.’ Then you will begin to say, ‘We ate and drank in your presence, and you taught in our streets.’ But he will say, ‘I tell you, I do not know where you come from. Depart from me, all you workers of evil (Breakers of the Torah, his Commandments)!”

**John 12:48** The one who rejects me and does not receive my words has a judge; the word that I have spoken will judge him on the last day.

**Luke 9:26** For whoever is ashamed of Me and My words, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when He comes in His esteem (glory) and that of the Father and the Kadosh (holy) angels.

**Zephaniah 2** Gather together, gather yourselves, nation devoid of shame; **2** before the decree takes effect, and the day comes when one passes like chaff; before **אֲיָאֵל**

(Yahuah)'s fierce anger comes on you, before the day of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)'s anger comes on you. **3** Seek אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), all you humble in the land, you who exercise his justice; seek righteousness, seek humility you might be hidden on the day of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)'s anger.

**Matthew 25:31-46** “When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the Malakim (angels) with him, then he will sit on his glorious throne. Before him will be gathered all the nations, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. And he will place the sheep on his right, but the goats on the left. Then the King will say to those on his right, ‘Come, you who are Baruch (blessed) by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world. For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me. **36** I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.’ **37** Then the righteous will answer him, saying, ‘Master, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? **38** And when did we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? **39** And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?’ **40** And the King will answer them, ‘Truly, I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brothers, you did it to me.’ **41** “Then he will say to those on his left, ‘Depart from me, you cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels. **42** For I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me no drink, **43** I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not clothe me, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.’ **44** Then they also will answer, saying, ‘Masterd, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not minister to you?’ **45** Then he will answer them, saying, ‘Truly, I say to you, as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me.’ **46** And these will go away into eternal punishment (Termination, Extenguising their Living Spirit, the second death), but the righteous into eternal life.”

**John 12:31** Now is the judgment of this world; now will the ruler of this world be cast out.

**1 Corinthians 15:52** in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last Shaof (trumpet). For the Shaofar (trumpet) will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.

**Revelation 8:2** And I saw the seven angels who stand before אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), and seven trumpets were given to them.

**Revelation 8:6** And the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound them.

**Revelation 8:7** The first sounded, and there came hail and fire, mixed with blood, and they were thrown to the earth; and a third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up.

**Revelation 8:8** The second angel sounded, and something like a great mountain burning

with fire was thrown into the sea; and a third of the sea became blood,

**Revelation 8:10** The third angel sounded, and a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of waters.

**Revelation 8:12** The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck, so that a third of them would be darkened and the day would not shine for a third of it, and the night in the same way.

**Revelation 9:1** Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him.

**Revelation 9:13** Then the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before **יְהוָה** (Yahuah),

**Revelation 11:15** Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) and of His Messiah; and He will reign forever and ever.

**Daniel 7:22** until the Ancient One (**יְהוָה** -Yahuah)-the Most High--came and judged in favor of his Kadosh (holy) people. Then the time arrived for the Kadosh (holy) people to take over the kingdom.

**Matthew 24:31** And he will send his angels with a loud Shofar (trumpet) call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other.

**Zechariah 12:8** On that day **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) will shield those who live in Jerusalem, so that the feeblest among them will be like David, and the house of David will be like **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), like the angel of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) going before them.

**Revelation 14:1** Then I looked, and behold, on Mount Zion stood the Lamb, and with him 144,000 who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads. 2 And I heard a voice from heaven like the roar of many waters and like the sound of loud thunder. The voice I heard was like the sound of harpists playing on their harps, 3 and they were singing a new song before the throne and before the four living creatures and before the elders. No one could learn that song except the 144,000 who had been redeemed from the earth. 4 It is these who have not defiled themselves with women, for they are virgins. It is these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These have been redeemed from mankind as firstfruits for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) and the Lamb, 5 and in their mouth no lie was found, for they are blameless. 6 Then I saw another angel flying directly overhead, with an eternal gospel to proclaim to those who dwell on earth, to every nation and tribe and language and people. 7 And he said with a loud voice, "Fear **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come, and worship him who made heaven and earth, the sea and the springs of water."

8 Another angel, a second, followed, saying, "Fallen, fallen is Babylon the great, she who made all nations drink the wine of the passion of her sexual immorality." 9 And another angel, a third, followed them, saying with a loud voice, "If any one worships the beast and its image and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand, 10 he also will drink the wine of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah)'s wrath, poured full strength into the cup of his anger, and he will be tormented with fire and sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and in

the presence of the Lamb. 11 And the smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever, and they have no rest, day or night, these worshipers of the beast and its image, and whoever receives the mark of its name.” 12 Here is a call for the endurance of the saints, those who keep the commandments of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah) and their faith in OʷYָּאָל (Yahusha). 13 And I heard a voice from heaven saying, “Write this: Baruch (Blessed) are the dead who die in OʷYָּאָל (Yahusha) from now on.” “Baruch (Blessed) indeed,” says the Ruach (Spirit), “that they may rest from their labors, for their deeds follow them!” 14 Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and seated on the cloud one like a son of man, with a golden crown on his head, and a sharp sickle in his hand. 15 And another angel came out of the temple, calling with a loud voice to him who sat on the cloud, “Put in your sickle, and reap, for the hour to reap has come, for the harvest of the earth is fully ripe.” 16 So he who sat on the cloud swung his sickle across the earth, and the earth was reaped.

**Revelation 6:** Next I watched as the Lamb broke the first of the seven seals, and I heard one of the four living beings say in a thundering voice, “Go!” 2 I looked, and there in front of me was a white horse; its rider had a bow and was given a crown; and he rode off as a conqueror to conquer. 3 When he broke the second seal, I heard the second living being say, “Go!” 4 Another horse went out, a red one; and its rider was given the power to take peace away from the earth and make people slaughter each other. He was given a great sword. 5 When he broke the third seal, I heard the third living being say, “Go!” I looked, and there in front of me was a black horse, and its rider held in his hand a pair of scales. 6 Then I heard what sounded like a voice from among the four living beings say, “Two pounds of wheat for a day’s wages! Six pounds of barley for the same price! But don’t damage the oil or the wine!” 7 When he broke the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living being say, “Go!” 8 I looked, and there in front of me was a pallid, sickly-looking horse. Its rider’s name was Death, and Sh’ol followed behind him. They were given authority to kill one-quarter of the world by war, by famine, by plagues and with the wild animals of the earth. 9 When the Lamb broke the fifth seal, I saw underneath the altar the souls of those who had been put to death for proclaiming the Word of אַיָּאָל (Yahuah), that is, for bearing witness. 10 They cried out in a loud voice, “Sovereign Ruler, *HaKadosh*, the True One, how long will it be before you judge the people living on earth and avenge our blood?” 11 Each of them was given a white robe; and they were told to wait a little longer, until the full number of their fellow-servants should be reached, of their brothers who would be killed, just as they had been. 12 Then I watched as he broke the sixth seal, and there was a great earthquake, the sun turned black as sackcloth worn in mourning, and the full moon became blood-red. 13 The stars fell from heaven to earth just as a fig tree drops its figs when shaken by a strong wind. 14 The sky receded like a scroll being rolled up, and every mountain and island was moved from its place. 15 Then the earth’s kings, the rulers, the generals, the rich and the mighty — indeed, everyone, slave and free — hid himself in caves and among the rocks in the mountains, 16 and said to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us, and hide

us from the face of the One sitting on the throne and from the fury of the Lamb! **17** For the Great Day of their fury has come, and who can stand?

**Revelation 16:1-20 The First Bowl** Then I heard a loud voice from the sanctuary saying to the seven angels, “Go and pour out the seven bowls of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)’s wrath on the earth.” **2** The first went and poured out his bowl on the earth, and severely painful sores broke out on the people who had the mark of the beast and who worshiped his image. **The Second Bowl 3** The second poured out his bowl into the sea. It turned to blood like a dead man’s, and all life in the sea died. **The Third Bowl** The third poured out his bowl into the rivers and the springs of water, and they became blood. **5** I heard the angel of the waters say: You are righteous, who is and who was, the Kadosh (Holy) One, for You have decided these things. **6** Because they poured out the blood of the Chosen and the prophets, You also gave them blood to drink; they deserve it! **7** Then I heard someone from the altar say: Yes, **OWYָּאֵל** (Yahusha) Alahym (God), the Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments. **The Fourth Bowl 8** The fourth poured out his bowl on the sun. He was given the power to burn people with fire, **9** and people were burned by the intense heat. So they blasphemed the name of **OWYָּאֵל** (Yahusha), who had the power over these plagues, and they did not repent and give Him glory. **The Fifth Bowl 10** The fifth poured out his bowl on the throne of the beast, and his kingdom was plunged into darkness. People gnawed their tongues because of their pain **11** and blasphemed the Aloah (God) of the heavens because of their pains and their sores, yet they did not repent of their actions. **The Sixth Bowl 12** The sixth poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up to prepare the way for the kings from the east. **13** Then I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming from the dragon’s mouth, from the beast’s mouth, and from the mouth of the false prophet. **14** For they are spirits of demons performing signs, who travel to the kings of the whole world to assemble them for the battle of the great day of אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah), the Almighty. **15** “Look, I am coming like a thief. The one who is alert and remains clothed so that he may not go around naked and people see his shame is blessed.” **16** So they assembled them at the place called in Hebrew, Armagedon. **The Seventh Bowl 17** Then the seventh poured out his bowl into the air, and a loud voice came out of the sanctuary from the throne, saying, “It is done!” **18** There were flashes of lightning and rumblings of thunder. And a severe earthquake occurred like no other since man has been on the earth—so great was the quake. **19** The great city split into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell. Babylon the Great was remembered in אַיָּאֵל (Yahuah)’s presence; He gave her the cup filled with the wine of His fierce anger. **20** Every island fled, and the mountains disappeared.

**Revelation 17** Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and said to me, “Come, I will show you the judgment of the great prostitute who is seated on many waters, **2** with whom the kings of the earth have committed sexual immorality, and with the wine of whose sexual immorality the dwellers on earth have become drunk.” **3** And he carried me away in the Ruach (Spirit) into a wilderness, and I saw a

woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was full of blasphemous names (The Lord, God, Jesus, Jehovah), and it had seven heads and ten horns. **4** The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and jewels and pearls, holding in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the impurities of her sexual immorality. **5** And on her forehead was written a name of mystery: "Babylon the great, mother of prostitutes and of earth's abominations." **6** And I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the chosen (believers), the blood of the martyrs of **וְיָשׁוּעַ** (Yahusha). When I saw her, I marveled greatly. **7** But the angel said to me, "Why do you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the woman, and of the beast with seven heads and ten horns that carries her. **8** The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to rise from the bottomless pit and go to destruction. And the dwellers on earth whose names have not been written in the book of life from the foundation of the world will marvel to see the beast, because it was and is not and is to come. **9** This calls for a mind with wisdom: the seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman is seated; **10** they are also seven kings, five of whom have fallen, one is, the other has not yet come, and when he does come he must remain only a little while. **11** As for the beast that was and is not, it is an eighth but it belongs to the seven, and it goes to destruction. **12** And the ten horns that you saw are ten kings who have not yet received royal power, but they are to receive authority as kings for one hour, together with the beast. **13** These are of one mind, and they hand over their power and authority to the beast. **14** They will make war on the Lamb, and the Lamb will conquer them, for he is Master of Masters and King of kings, and those with him are called and chosen and faithful." **15** And the angel said to me, "The waters that you saw, where the prostitute is seated, are peoples and multitudes and nations and languages. **16** And the ten horns that you saw, they and the beast will hate the prostitute. They will make her desolate and naked, and devour her flesh and burn her up with fire, **17** for **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) has put it into their hearts to carry out his purpose by being of one mind and handing over their royal power to the beast, until the words of **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) are fulfilled. **18** And the woman that you saw is the great city that has dominion over the kings of the earth."

**Micah 1:2** Hear, O peoples, all of you; Listen, O earth and all it contains, And let **יְהוָה** (Yahuah), Aloah (God) be a witness against you, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) from His Kadosh (holy) temple. For behold, **יְהוָה** (Yahuah) is coming forth from His place. He will come down and tread on the high places of the earth....

**Daniel 7:13** I continued watching in the night visions, and I saw One like a son of man coming with the clouds of heaven. He approached the Ancient of Days (**יְהוָה** -Yahuah) and was escorted before Him.

**Revelation 1:7** "Look, he is coming with the clouds," and "every eye will see him, even those who pierced him"; and all peoples on earth "will mourn because of him." So shall it be! Amen.

**Revelation 19:11-15** Next I saw heaven opened, and there before me was a white horse. Sitting on it was the one called Faithful and True, and it is in righteousness that he

passes judgment and goes to battle. 12 His eyes were like a fiery flame, and on his head were many royal crowns. And he had a name written which no one knew but himself. 13 He was wearing a robe that had been soaked in blood, and the name by which he is called is, "The Word of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah)." 14 The armies of heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and pure, were following him on white horses. 15 And out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down nations — "He will rule them with a staff of iron." It is he who treads the winepress from which flows the wine of the furious rage of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), Aloah (God) of heaven's armies.

**Revelation 11:19** Then אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah)'s temple in the heavens was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen within his temple. There were flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake, and heavy hail.

**Isaiah 40:5** And the esteem (glory) of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) will appear, and all humanity together will see it, for the mouth of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) has spoken.

**Isaiah 30:27-30** Behold, the name of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) comes from afar, burning with his anger, and in thick rising smoke; his lips are full of fury, and his tongue is like a devouring fire; 28 his breath is like an overflowing stream that reaches up to the neck; to sift the nations with the sieve of destruction, and to place on the jaws of the peoples a bridle that leads astray. 29 You shall have a song as in the night when a Kadosh (holy) feast is kept, and gladness of heart, as when one sets out to the sound of the flute to go to the mountain of אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), to the Rock of Israel. 30 And אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah) will cause his majestic voice to be heard and the descending blow of his arm to be seen, in furious anger and a flame of devouring fire, with a cloudburst and storm and hailstones.

**Isaiah 34:4** All the stars in the sky will be dissolved and the heavens rolled up like a scroll; all the starry host will fall like withered leaves from the vine, like shriveled figs from the fig tree.

**Isaiah 54:10** Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed," says אַיָּהוָה (Yahuah), who has compassion on you.

**Jeremiah 4:24** I looked at the mountains, and they were quaking; all the hills were swaying.

**Ezekiel 38:20** The fish in the sea, the birds in the sky, the beasts of the field, every creature that moves along the ground, and all the people on the face of the earth will tremble at my presence. The mountains will be overturned, the cliffs will crumble and every wall will fall to the ground.

**Nahum 1:5** The mountains quake before him and the hills melt away. The earth trembles at his presence, the world and all who live in it.

**Revelation 20:4** Then I saw thrones, and seated on them were those to whom the authority to judge was committed. Also I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded

for the testimony of **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) and for the word of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), and those who had not worshiped the beast or its image and had not received its mark on their foreheads or their hands. They came to life and reigned with Messiah for a thousand years.

**Joel 2:11-13** **AYAZL** (Yahuah) utters his voice before his army, for his camp is exceedingly great; he who executes his word is powerful. For the day of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) is great and very awesome; who can endure it? “Yet even now,” declares **AYAZL** (Yahuah), “return to me with all your heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning; and rend your hearts and not your garments.” Return to **AYAZL** (Yahuah) your Aloah (God), for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love; and he relents over disaster.

**Isaiah 26:21** See, **AYAZL** (Yahuah) is coming out of his dwelling to punish the people of the earth for their sins. The earth will disclose the blood shed on it; the earth will conceal its slain no longer.

**Isaiah 64:1** Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you!

**Zechariah 9:14** Then **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will appear over them, And His arrow will go forth like lightning; And **AYAZL** (Yahuah) Aloah (GOD) will blow the trumpet, And will march in the storm winds of the south. 15 **AYAZL** (Yahuah) of hosts will defend them.

**Isaiah 64:1** Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you! As when fire sets twigs ablaze and causes water to boil, come down to make your **name** known to your enemies and cause the nations to quake before you!

**Habakkuk 3:6** He stood, and shook the earth; he looked, and made the nations tremble. The ancient mountains crumbled and the age-old hills collapsed-- but he marches on forever.

**Amos 4:8-13** He who forms the mountains, who creates the wind, and who reveals his thoughts to mankind, who turns dawn to darkness, and treads on the heights of the earth-- **AYAZL** (Yahuah) Aloah (God) Almighty is his name. The Ancient of Days Reigns **9** “As I looked, thrones were placed, and the Ancient of Days took his seat; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames; its wheels were burning fire. **10** A stream of fire issued and came out from before him; a thousand thousands served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him; the court sat in judgment, and the books were opened. **11** “I looked then because of the sound of the great words that the horn was speaking. And as I looked, the beast was killed, and its body destroyed and given over to be burned with fire. **12** As for the rest of the beasts, their dominion was taken away, but their lives were prolonged for a season and a time. **13** “I saw in the night visions, and behold, with the clouds of heaven there came one like a son of man, and he came to the Ancient of Days (**AYAZL** (Yahuah) and

was presented before him. **14** And to him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.

**Revelation 20** Next I saw an angel coming down from the heavens, who had the key to the Abyss and a great chain in his hand. **2** He seized the dragon, that ancient serpent, who is the Devil and Satan [the Adversary], and chained him up for a thousand years. **3** He threw him into the Abyss, locked it and sealed it over him; so that he could not deceive the nations any more until the thousand years were over. After that, he has to be set free for a little while. **4** Then I saw thrones, and those seated on them received authority to judge. And I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for testifying about **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) and proclaiming the Word of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), also those who had not worshipped the beast or its image and had not received the mark on their foreheads and on their hands. They came to life and ruled with the Messiah for a thousand years. **5** (The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were over.) This is the first resurrection. **6** Blessed and holy is anyone who has a part in the first resurrection; over him the second death has no power. On the contrary, they will be cohanim (Priests) of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) and of the Messiah, and they will rule with him for the thousand years. **7** When the thousand years are over, the Adversary will be set free from his prison **8** and will go out to deceive the nations in the four quarters of the earth, **Gog and Magog**, [a] to gather them for the battle. Their number is countless as the sand on the seashore; **9** and they came up over the breadth of the Land and surrounded the camp of **AYAZL** (Yahuah)'s people and the city he loves. But fire came down from heaven and consumed them. **10** The Adversary who had deceived them was hurled into the lake of fire and sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet were; and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever. **11** Next I saw a great white throne and the One sitting on it. Earth and heaven fled from his presence, and no place was found for them. **12** And I saw the dead, both great and small, standing in front of the throne. Books were opened; and another book was opened, the Book of Life; and the dead were judged from what was written in the books, according to what they had done. **13** The sea gave up the dead in it; and Death and She'ol gave up the dead in them; and they were judged, each according to what he had done. **14** Then Death and She'ol were hurled into the lake of fire. This is the second death — the lake of fire. **15** Anyone whose name was not found written in the Book of Life was hurled into the lake of fire.

**Micah 4:1-3** It shall come to pass in the latter days that the mountain of the house of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) shall be established as the highest of the mountains, and it shall be lifted up above the hills; and peoples shall flow to it, and many nations shall come, and say: "Come, let us go up to the mountain of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), to the house of the Alahym (God) of Jacob, that he may teach us his ways and that we may walk in his paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) from Jerusalem. He shall judge between many peoples, and shall decide for strong nations far away; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation

shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.

**Isaiah 2:4** He shall judge between the nations, and shall decide disputes for many peoples; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks; nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore.

**2 Thessalonians 1:5-10** This is evidence of the righteous judgment of **OWYAZL** (Yahusha), that you may be considered worthy of the kingdom of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), for which you are also suffering— since indeed **AYAZL** (Yahuah) considers it just to repay with affliction those who afflict you, and to grant relief to you who are afflicted as well as to us, when the Master **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) is revealed from heaven with his mighty angels in flaming fire, inflicting vengeance on those who do not know **AYAZL** (Yahuah) and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Master **OWYAZL** (Yahusha). They will suffer the punishment of eternal destruction, away from the presence of **AYAZL** (Yahuah) and from the glory of his might, ..

**Isaiah 59:15-20** Honesty is lacking, he who leaves evil becomes a target. **AYAZL** (Yahuah) saw it, and it displeased him that there was no justice. 16 He saw that there was no one, was amazed that no one interceded. Therefore his own arm brought him salvation, and his own righteousness sustained him. 17 He put on righteousness as his breastplate, salvation as a helmet on his head; he clothed himself with garments of vengeance and wrapped himself in a mantle of zeal. 18 He repays according to their deeds —fury to his foes, reprisal to his enemies; to the coastlands he will repay their due; 19 in the west they will fear the name of **AYAZL** (Yahuah), and likewise, in the east, his glory. For he will come like a pent-up stream, impelled by the Ruach (Spirit) of **AYAZL** (Yahuah). 20 “Then a Redeemer will come to Tziyon, to those in Ya‘akov who turn from rebellion.” So says **AYAZL** (Yahuah).

**1 Corinthians 4:5** Therefore do not pronounce judgment before the time, before **OWYAZL** (Yahusha) comes, who will bring to light the things now hidden in darkness and will disclose the purposes of the heart. Then each one will receive his commendation from **AYAZL** (Yahuah).

**Ecclesiastes 12:12-14** My son, beware of anything beyond these. Of making many books there is no end, and much study is a weariness of the flesh. The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear **AYAZL** (Yahuah) and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. For **AYAZL** (Yahuah) will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.
